Whenever any officer shall be employed in the command of a squadron, on separate service, the allowance of rations shall be double during the continuance of such command, and no longer, except in the case of the commanding officer of the navy, whose allowance while in service shall always be at the rate of sixteen rations per day, agreeably to an act of Congress passed 25th February, 1799.
